Policy

- **Participate in new ESHA Friday Policy Chat!** – With more and more members interested in taking part in ESHA's policy work (through the Policy Working Group), Project and Policy Manager Oliver Jung organises a one hour information exchange on Skype every second Friday at 14.00. Next dates will be the 13th and 27th of July as well as the 10th and 24th of August. - **Consultation on expected EC Water Blueprint** – ESHA and its members participated in this important on-line consultation on the future of EU water policy. Please find ESHA's response [here](#).
- **New contacts with DG Enterprise** – ESHA's President Marko Gospodjinački and the representative of Småkraftforeninga, the Norwegian Small Hydropower Association, Henrik Glette established new links with representatives from DG Enterprise. During a meeting, they discussed possible joint measures to promote the small hydropower sector in Europe and abroad.

- **Consultation on IEE III in Horizon 2020** – The EC launched a consultation on Horizon 2020 and IEE III. If you are interested in the future of Europe's research policy, please send your comments to us or respond by the 5th of September [here](#).
- **EU Energy Policy** – the European Commission presented on the 6th of June its *Communication on its renewable energy policy*, outlining options for the period beyond 2020 [[see document](#) & [EREC press release](#)]. The European Council failed to adopt the conclusions on the *Energy Roadmap 2050* [[see document](#) & [EREC press release](#)].
- **Study on cost analysis series for renewable energy technologies** – IRENA published an interesting study on this topic, including a part on hydro. [read IRENA study on hydro](#).

- The Secretariat finalised and followed up on *hidroenergia 2012* in June. This year's ESHA's traditional congress and trade fair (Wrocław, Poland, 23-26 May 2012) attracted more than 600 participants including twelve sponsors and 52 exhibitors from 44 countries. EU co-sponsored projects

- ESHA's flagship project *Stream Map* ended after three years in May 2012. Its main results are the [HYDI database](#) containing energy, market and policy information about the small hydropower sector in the 27 EU member states and the SHP Roadmap which lines out the prerequisites for the development of the sector. The Secretariat will publish the final version of the Roadmap together with a final project report by the end of July. For more information, please contact [Martina Steinkusz](#).
 - ESHA's new flagship project *RESTOR Hydro* started with a kick-off meeting including a training session on IEE project management in Brussels on the 11th and 12th of June. The project will continue updating the HYDI database, will develop an EU-wide database of former SHP sites which are able to be refurbished/re-activated and will promote cooperatives as an investment tool for SHP sites.  - In the framework of the project **StoRE**, the Secretariat organised a third round table in Brussels on the 19th of June to consult relevant stakeholders on the European regulatory and market framework to facilitate storage. For more information, please contact [Oliver Jung](#).
